Created in **1883**, following a split with neighbouring Lanouée, Les Forges covers more than **5250 ha (12600 acres) of which 3800 ha (9120 acres) comprise woodland**, still known as the Forest of Lanouée. We are located on the border of the Côtes d'Armor to the north and bounded by the **Nantes-Brest Canal** to the west, and we boast no less than three rivers: **the Oust, the Lié and the Ninian.**

Situated as we are **between forest and water**, we have a rich natural and cultural heritage just waiting to be discovered: the forest itself; [the château and its gardens "à la française", the old foundry furnace and the hydro-electric generating station;](#)
